Wood may not be brought in from the field on יום טוב, even if it was prepared before יום טוב because of עובדא דחול.

It is אסור to chop wood from a stack of beams that were set aside for other purposes. It is also אסור to use a beam that broke on יום טוב, if it had been previously set aside.

The wood may only be cut with a knife, but not with an ax. they may also be broken by hand.

If food was locked up in a house and not accessible on יום טוב, if the wall was breached the food may be removed and is not מוקצה (unlike food kept in a storehouse which is מוקצה).

Bricks left over from a building may be moved on שבת as they are now suitable for sitting upon (if the bricks are stacked showing that their is intent upon them being used again, they may not be moved).

As long as a rope is not tied in a professional knot (a double knot) or a knot that is meant to last more than a day, it is מותר to untie on שבת or יום טוב.
