There is to be paid the sum of \$150.00 for each of the graves disintered, totaling \$450.00 for the future maintenance. Remove Head Stones and Foundations and level ground to the original normal surface at the expense of the Jacobs Family.

This letter terminates any and all claims to the above plots by the Jacob's Family and reverts to the ownership of the North Park Society to use as they see fit.

All arrangements to disinter, is to be made by the Jacob's Family, with the proper supervision of a licensed Jewish Mortician and assume all expenses incurred for the removal of the above mentioned remains and must pay to the North Park Society \$450.00 before disinterment.
