An object rescued from a lion, bear, or found in a strong river, the object belongs to the one that found it, even if the owner is standing and yelling adds the רמ"א, as the owner was מייאש.

If a person lost or had stolen from him chickens or goats, and then found them שחוטים כראוי in an are of רוב ישראל, the animals are כשר.

A בהמה found between ירושלים and מגדל עדר, or the distance thereof in any direction, if it is a נקבה a year old, it is considered a חטאת and brought in until it dies. If it is two years, it is offered as a שלמים. If it is a זכר, if it is two years old, nothing is done with it. If it is a year old, it is left until it develops a מום.

An עולה brought by a גוי does not have נסכים from the גוי offered with it, rather, the נסכים are given from the צבור.

A גר that died and left behind זבחים, if he has נסכים they are offered, if not, they are purchased from monies of תרומת הלשכה.

The כהנים can benefit from עצים and מלח of the מקדש, however, they may not place מלח of the מקדש on food of חולין.
