Wool and flax garments are מקבל טומאה if they are 3x3 fingerbreadths (and for מדרס [טומאה caused by sitting upon an object] the garment needs to be 3x3 טפחים). Other garments need to be 3x3 טפחים to be מקבל טומאה.

Anything that is woven from wool, flax, cannabis, silk or anything else that grows from the ground is called a בגד.

The איסור of wearing שעטנו only refers to wool made from ewes and sheep. Wool made from camel, rabbits, or any other animal, is permitted to be worn with linen.

In order for a בגד to be obligated in ציצית מדאורייתא the garment must be made from wool or linen.

ציצית may be made from wool or linen irregardless of the בגד, otherwise the ציצית must be made from the same material as the garment.

A blind person is obligated in ציצית (the words וראיתם אותם comes to exclude a garment specifically made for night, as night is not a time for ציצית).

Flax that has been spun may not be used for סכך for a סוכה, because even though it grows from the ground, it has been processed and can therefore be מקבל טומאה.

All threads made from wool or linen in the warp and the woof are מקבל טומאת צרעת immediately.

Material made from a tree that has been processed and is used as a roof,

contracts טומאת אהל, but boards from a tree, do not.
